David D'Or is a singer, an instrumentalist, and a brilliant composer. He graduated from the Jerusalem Academy of Music and has won numerous awards and competitions. He was invited to perform for the Pope in Vatican City; specifically, he composed a song for the 20-year service celebration for the Pope. Most recently, David was invited by the monarchy in Thailand to perform at the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the reign of the king.

David D'Or has been deeply touched by Tzu Chi founder Dharma Master Cheng Yen's wisdom, as well as Tzu Chi's humanitarian efforts across the world. These experiences have inspired him to write song such as “Like a Garden,” “We Are Family,” and “Living with Love.”

As a singer, David is known for his unique tone and range. As a composer, his works reflect his love and compassion toward all living beings and the environment. His beautiful voice connects the souls of human beings in the world, spreading the seeds of love everywhere he goes.

John Yin is known for his passionate performances and his ability to move his audience by pouring his heart and soul into his songs. His motto for singing is: “Sing good songs, and sing them well.”

D'Or and Yin are touring throughout the United States, performing concerts to spread good thoughts and boundless Great Love. All proceeds from their performances will be donated to the Tzu Chi Foundation to carry out its charity work.
